IBADAN 2012

THIS was the sixth national conference of the Association and it held between the 20th and 22nd of June, 2012. The venue was Premier hotel in Ibadan, the capital of Oyo State, Nigeria.

The key note address was delivered by Prof Femi Soyinka, which focused on the theme of the conference: "The Challenges of Practice of Dermatology in West Africa". The sub-theme was "Aesthetic Dermatology".

The annual conference was preceded by a training workshop in Aesthetic Dermatology (see photographs below) which was run by an invited expert in the field from the United States of America, Dr. Temitope Soares. He demonstrated some practical skills such as a practical way to inject Keloidal scars and acne keloid, shave biopsy technic using a razor blade. Patch testing was demonstrated. A resource person demonstrated essentials of photography in dermatology. Make-up artists were invited and demonstrated masking of the skin colour for hypopigmented diseases like vitiligo.

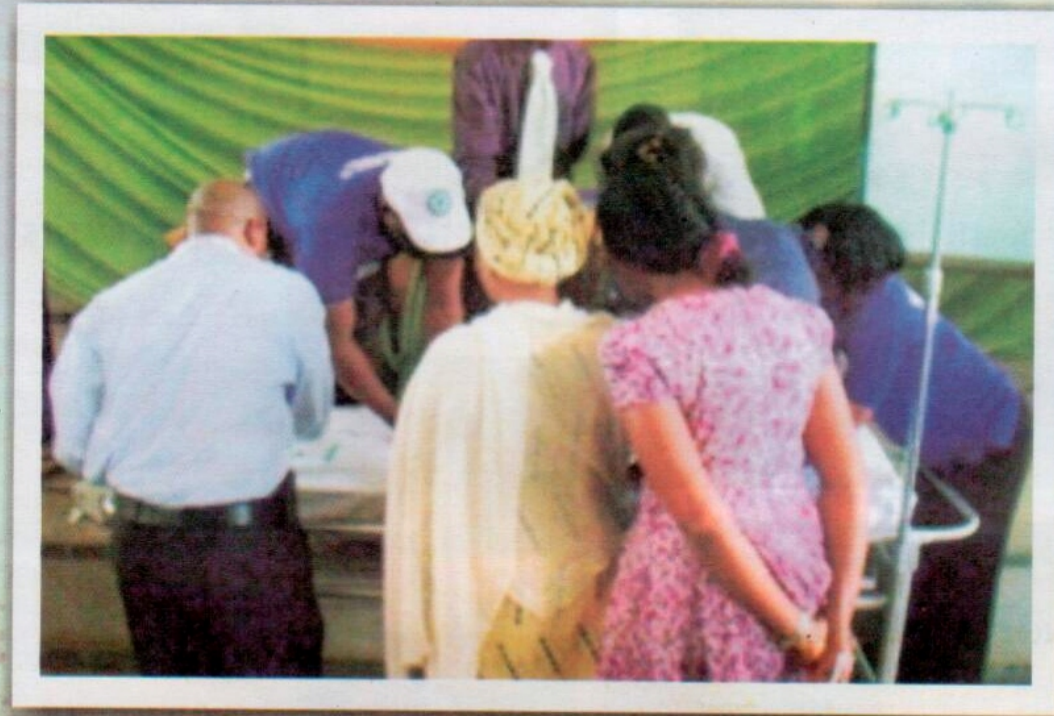
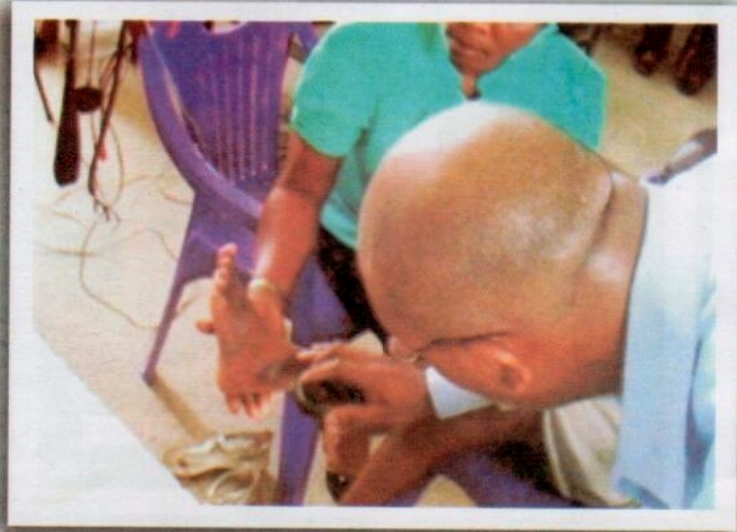

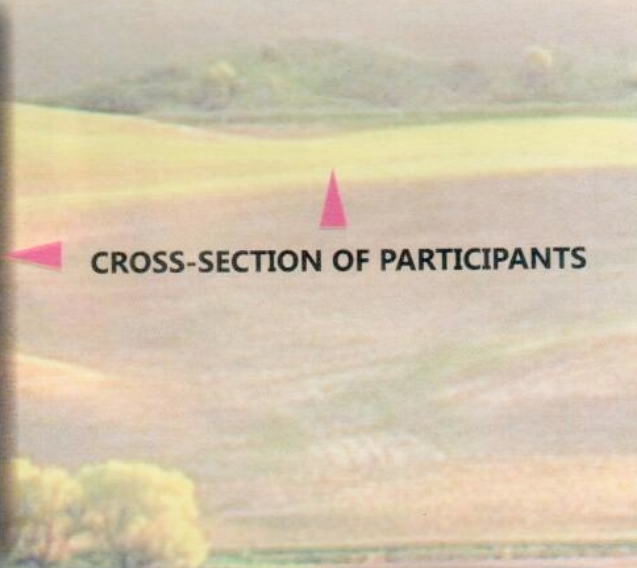


▲

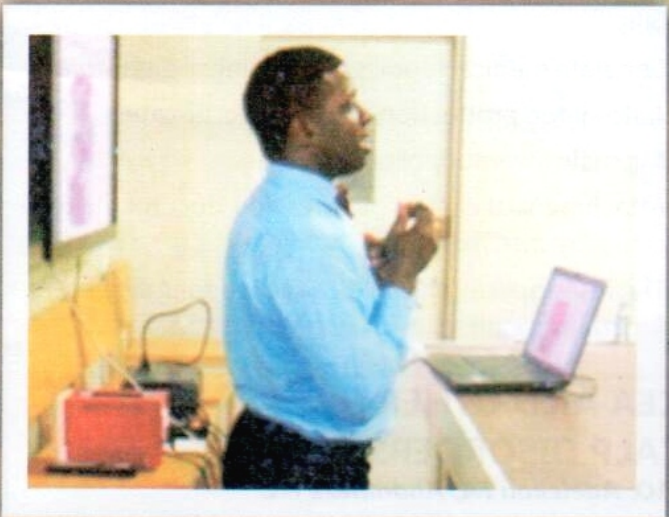
